There were no vitals taken for this visit.

Constitutional: well developed, well nourished

Ability to communicate: hearing adequate

Quality of voice: Normal

Head and Face: no abnormal findings

External Nose: no external deformity

Nasal mucosa: turbinates normal, no nasal polyps and by endoscopy

Nasopharynx: nasopharynx clear without lesion via endoscopy

Lips teeth gums: no lesions, no ecchymosis, no edema, dentition normal and no gingivitis

Oral cavity/Oropharynx: mucosa normal without lesion or ulceration, tonsils without enlargement or exudate and base of tongue & tonsils symmetric & soft without masses on palpation, base of tongue normal on scope

Pharyngeal wall/pyriform: no lesions and no edema

Larynx: true vocal cords mobile, pyriforms, vallecula, epiglottis within normal limits, via endoscopy

Neck: normal thyroid

Lymph: 2 large right level 2-3 lymph nodes, each about 3 cm, right submandibular gland also more anterior than normal so may have additional nodes adjacent

Fine Needle Aspiration Biopsy Procedure:

After full discussion of risks (bleeding, infection, insufficient sample requiring need for repeat FNA or other type of biopsy) and benefits of FNA biopsy were discussed, the patient verbally consented for the procedure. 2 milliliters of 1% lidocaine with 1:100,000 epinephrine and bicarbonate buffer was infiltrated in skin over right neck mass. 3 passes with 22 gauge needle were performed and tissue was placed on 3 sets of slides, each with one air dry slide and one alcohol fixed slide. Cells were also placed in solution. All 3 were good samples without blood.
